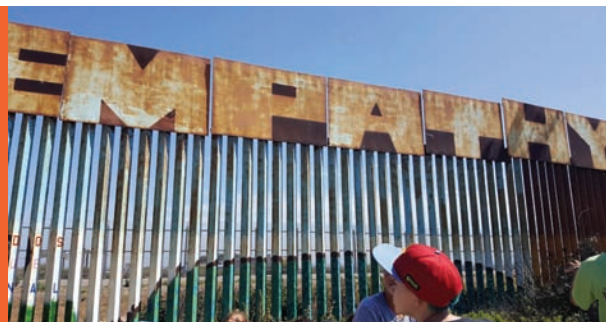

San Diego: Community Project Request

The Sierra Service Project (SSP) is a nonprofit organization committed to strengthening communities through service to others. SSP's home and facility repair and community service work is done by teenage and adult volunteers who are supervised by experienced paid staff. This will be SSP's third summer serving in San Diego.

SSP volunteers are able to do these kinds of projects:

- **Facility repair** for local nonprofits, schools, churches or community buildings that benefit the entire community and not just individual families.
- **Community volunteering** like beach clean-up, dune restoration, community garden work, etc.
- **Home repairs for low-income homeowners** (*see separate home repair work request form.*)

After receiving a project request, an SSP employee will visit your site to evaluate the work requested. It is not possible to complete all requested projects due to time, budget and volunteer limitations. A visit to your site does not guarantee that a project will be approved. SSP will do all work promised by this employee. The project will be scheduled between July 3 and August 11, 2017.

In order to receive our services you must:

- **Complete a Community Project Request Form**
- **Provide or share in the cost of any building materials needed**
- **Provide specialized tools SSP may not have for unique project types**
- **Have a representative present at times to educate teenage volunteers with background information valuable to their development and exposure to a new community**
