Greetings! The Sierra Service Project (SSP) is a nonprofit home-repair organization headquartered in North Sacramento. With a generous grant from the Wells Fargo Bank Foundation, we have launched a volunteer home repair program for North Sacramento residents.

The purpose of this program is to repair and beautify homes in North Sacramento for elderly or disabled residents. Our goal is to make homes safer and more comfortable for residents. The program will run from September through May. Sierra Service Project plans and supervises all of the work. We recruit volunteer teams from schools, churches, businesses, and community groups. We provide them with guidance, tools, and building materials they need.

Do you need any work done on your home? Details about the type of work our volunteers can accomplish are on the following page. Typical projects include yard cleanup, fence repair and replacement, handicap ramps and stairs, siding repair and replacement, and painting. To qualify, you must live in one of these neighborhoods: Old North Sacramento, Dixieanne, Noralto, Hagginwood, South Hagginwood, Ben Ali, East Del Paso Heights, Del Paso Heights, Strawberry Manor, West Del Paso Heights, Wills Acres, Richardson Village, Johnson Heights, or Oak Knoll.

If you are interested in taking advantage of this opportunity, please review the income requirements and complete the attached **Home Repair Work Request** and submit it via email, mail, or fax, or drop it off in person at the SSP office at 1516 Del Paso Boulevard.

Sierra Service Project (SSP) is a nonprofit organization committed to strengthening communities through service to others. Our services are provided **free-of-charge** to residents regardless of race, gender, disability, age, religion, or immigration status. SSP’s home repair work is done by **teenage and adult volunteers** who are supervised by experienced paid staff.

Project types SSP volunteers are able to complete:

- Yard cleanup
- Good neighbor fence repair and replacement
- Handicap ramps and stairs
- Siding repair and replacement
- Interior and exterior painting
- SSP is NOT able to repair windows, doors, and roofs or do any electrical or plumbing work.

After receiving a **Home Repair Work Request**, an SSP employee will visit your home to evaluate the work requested. It is not possible to complete all requested work due to time, budget, and volunteer limitations. A visit to your home does not guarantee that a project will be approved. SSP will do all work promised by this employee.

- Your income must be at or below the qualifying levels below:
